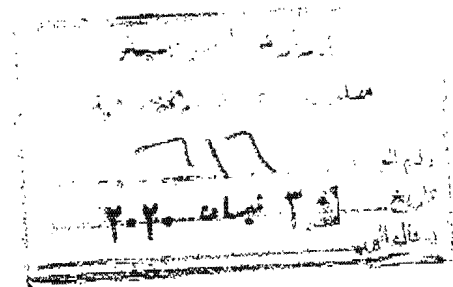

Dear Sir/ madam

The Pafos Chamber of Commerce & Industry would like to inform you that is operating normally since March 13th where the Ministerial Decrees of the Republic of Cyprus came into force by taking all the covid-19 interception protection measures in order to properly serve the companies/ business that deal with exporting goods to another country.


As you know according to *The Chambers of Commerce and Industry Act of 1968 (Law 56/ 1968) of the Republic of Cyprus*, article 6(d) is under the jurisdiction of the Local Chambers to certify the signatures of the traders and Industrialists, Members of the Chamber of Commerce, issue certificates of origin, certified and/ or legalized commercial invoices and proceed with sampling and the issuance of any other certificate relating to the export of products abroad.

To the countries that request by the Local Authorities the documents to be notarized, stamped and signed by the Local Chamber of Commerce, **please ensure that all companies provide these documents stamped and signed originally not digital or scanned by the local Chamber according to regulations.**

Cypriot Companies that present documents that do not have the above legal and necessary stamps and signature by the Local Chamber of Commerce, the Pafos Chamber of Commerce & Industry on behalf of the Cyprus Chamber of Commerce & Industry, does not find us in agreement nor do we know what they are trading on.
